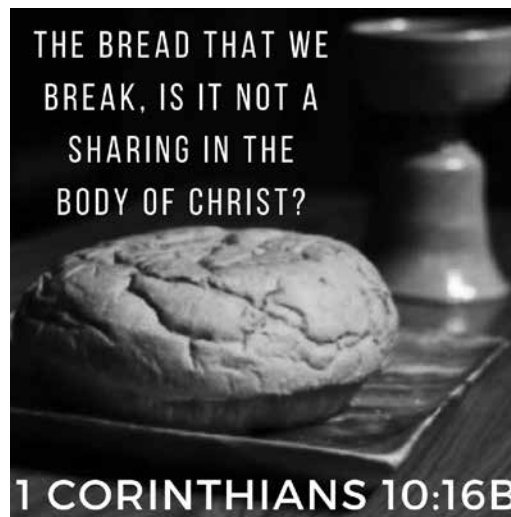

Forman Christian College was founded by a Presbyterian missionary in 1864 and was one of the first universities in India to admit women. Every year, female enrollment is increasing and many graduates are able to find jobs within the first six-months of graduating. The IPC Foundation currently supports 13 students on scholarships.
